The First Rail Slider in Japan

Niseko Village's Rail Slider in PURE is Japan's first of its kind. Suspended by wires and propelled by gravity, riders glide down rails with panoramic views of Mount Yotei in the distance. It's a fast-paced, oneof-a-kind thrill that merges coaster-like excitement with natural scenery.

Leap Into the Air with a Quick Jump

Feel the rush of free falling from 7 or 10 meters high with the PURE Quick Jump. Safely designed with a gradual braking system, this drop tower attraction simulates the thrill of skydiving in a controlled environment. It's a must-try for daredevils looking to conquer their fears with a big leap.
