## From Rehabilitation to Re-Release: The Triumphant Return of a Sea Turtle's Journey of Survival and Conservation at Gaya Island Resort

Covid, who was named after the pandemic, was discovered in March 2020 near a water village by Pulau Gaya in a dire state, suffering from malnutrition and a damaged carapace. Thanks to the dedication and expert care of the Marine Centre team, this resilient turtle underwent intensive treatment, including surgeries, medication, acupuncture, and buoyancy therapy. These advanced medical interventions culminated in his recovery, allowing him to be released back into the sea on Merdeka Day this year with a satellite tracker to monitor his well-being and progress.

In a remarkable twist, Covid returned to Gaya Island Resort shortly after his release, perhaps drawn back by the care and attention he received from the Marine Centre team and resort guests. After spending some time at the resort, he was re-released into the sea on October 1, 2024, in excellent health.

Since his re-release, tracking data shows that Covid continues to navigate the waters around Gaya Island, with his most recent location recorded near Police Beach. By closely monitoring his movements, the Marine Centre gains invaluable insights into the behavior, migration patterns, and habitat preferences of sea turtles. This data not only supports ongoing efforts to protect these majestic creatures but also helps shape broader marine conservation strategies. Covid's journey is a testament to the importance of such initiatives and underscores Gaya Island Resort's unwavering commitment to the rehabilitation and preservation of marine life.
