

The itinerary ensures a perfect blend of adventure and relaxation, allowing guests to uncover the island's seven natural wonders, including the possible sightings of Proboscis Monkeys, Red Giant Flying Squirrels, Fireflies, Philippine Megapodes, the nocturnal Boobook Owl and Sunda Pangolin, as well as the Elephant Foot Yam and Mangrove.

It also covers full board and scheduled return boat transfers between Jesselton Point Ferry Terminal in Kota Kinabalu and the resort.

With daily nature briefings, twilight and dawn bird-watching excursions, and hands-on activities like mangrove kayaking and planting, the Wildlife Wonders package offers a unique opportunity to immerse yourself in Borneo's wild beauty and foster a profound appreciation for nature.
